What we've done and what's to come!

English:

Students have worked very hard this year to complete the entire GCSE English literature specification. These texts include:

- An Inspector Calls
- A Christmas Carol
- Romeo and Juliet
- 15 poems from the AQA poetry anthology We ended the year with our Spoken Language presentations so we can come back in September and get started on English language.

Maths:

Students have been challenged this term familiarising themselves with the exam questions from the new specification. In particular, we have focused on AO3 which is problem solving questions. These questions draw on students' literacy and maths abilities.

Science:

Additional students have now covered all of Physics P2 and are half way through Biology B2. Chemistry C2 will begin in the new year.

Core students are now focussing on consolidating their recall of all the Core Science content. Students should be familiarising themselves with the booklets.
