Bitesize

What's done and what's to come:

ENGLISH

This term English students have completed the rest of the specification. We started off the year with poetry—learning over 15 poems! Students have also finished reading 'A Christmas Carol' which they will write about in the 19th Century novel section of the literature exam.

MATHS

We have covered 80% of the content so far in Maths. Students have been challenged this term with the broader content from the new specification.

In January students will be given their personalised booklets after analysing the December Mocks. In addition there will be more students invited to the Saturday sessions where we will be running Foundation and Higher tier classes until June.

SCIENCE

Year 11 students have now covered B1, C1 and P1 and are partway through P2, C2. Students should now be focussing on really learning B1, C1 and P1 by using the AO1 knowledge booklets which can be found in P/Science/Revision.

Priority 1: Learn everything in the booklets.

Priority 2: Ask someone at home or a friend to test the student by reading out the questions.

They don't need to know any Science, just be able to read the questions and check that they know the answer!
