ENGLISH

This term the year 11s went to see a production of '[An Inspector Calls](#)' at New Wimbledon Theatre. In lessons we have revised the poetry anthology, 'A Christmas Carol' and 'Romeo and Juliet'. Next term we will be focusing on English language however students should keep literature revision on their revision timetables.

MATHS

Students will be given their personalised **Pinpoint Learning** booklets after analysing the December Mocks. The booklets have questions targeting areas for development.

Students should use Maths Watch to improve their understanding of any weak spots too. There are exercises to be completed as well as supportive videos that teach you how.

SCIENCE

This term the year 11s visited [Body Worlds](#) in Piccadilly Circus. We saw the human body in the unique exhibition and made links to B1 and B2.

Year 11 students have now covered B1, C1 and P1 and are partway through P2, C2.
