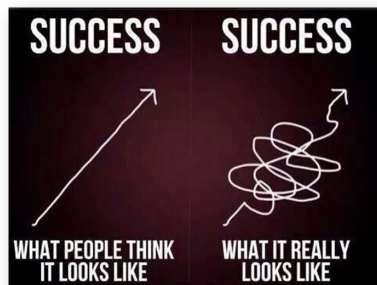


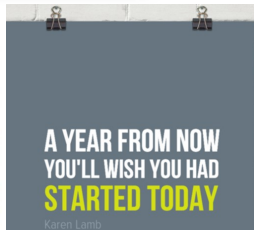

Exam Preparation:

On exam day students should:

- Arrive early for the exam at least 20mins. If you are running late or are ill, you must phone in to inform us.
- Tie long hair back.
- No electronic devices such as mobile phones are allowed.
- Only clear water bottles without labels are allowed.
- Listen carefully for your name to be called out. Sit in your allocated seat.
- Follow all Invigilator instructions. Please note that there will be external invigilators who will strictly follow the guidelines.
- you will not be allowed to leave an examination early, so please don't ask.

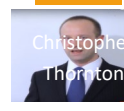
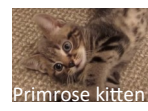
- Complete **pinpoint booklet** from your final mocks.
